Descriptions of Workshop Topics:

1. **“Arranging for Mountain Dulcimers”** – A step-by-step, hands-on approach to converting standard notation sheet music in any key to the dulcimer fretboard. (No previous ability to read standard notation required.)
2. **“Introduction to Jamming/Playing Backup”** – A number of useful techniques for “jam survival” will be presented, including chording, playing backup, and learning to play by ear.
3. **“Ensemble Playing”** – A number of multi-part arrangements will be presented, with different parts suitable for different playing skills.
