CLASS DESCRIPTIONS:

Mtn. Dulcimer – Playing in Other Keys: - *the mtn. dulcimer sometimes gets a "bad rap" of only being able to play in the key of D. This workshop will cover how to transpose tunes from one key to another, with and without a capo. D-A-d tuning, capo required. Advanced Beginner and up. ** see below*

Mtn. Dulcimer – Repertoire for Mtn. Dulcimer: - *we'll spend this session learning as many new tunes as time permits, pulled from an eclectic variety of styles and genres, such as fiddle tunes, classical, waltzes and aires, hymns and gospel tunes, old-time, pop, and contemporary. D-A-D tuning. Capo may be required for some tunes. Intermediate and up.*

Mtn. Dulcimer – Ensemble: *we'll cover multi-part arrangements for mixed skill levels. ** see below*

**** All beginner or novice level Mtn. Dulcimer participants should be comfortable with tuning, holding & strumming their dulcimer & have a basic knowledge of chords in D-A-D tuning.**

Steel Drum: *Beginner level class with the focus on capability of playing the steel drum in your club. Guy will bring as many as 10 steel drums for people to use for the class. At time of registration, please let me know if you'd like to use one of those 10. If you'd like to purchase one from him go to <http://www.guygeorge.com/>, order one, and he'll bring it down over & above the 10 he'll have available for use ... he'll throw in a free Jumbie Jam Christmas book if you buy one.*

Pennywhistle: *the a.m. pennywhistle class will be for the beginner level. Guy will have some great-sounding 'D' pennywhistles available at \$25 & up. They'll be available for purchase before the workshop begins. If you bring your own whistle, it must be in the key of 'D'.*

The p.m. pennywhistle class will be for the intermediate level. Those taking the a.m. class are welcome to also register for the p.m. class.

Hammered Dulcimer: *will be for the intermediate level & up & will be a repertoire class with back up parts. We'll learn as many new tunes as time permits.*

Guy will incorporate all the steel drum, pennywhistle, and hammered dulcimer tunes so that participants of all classes can play together with the different parts you'll learn. Sounds like fun... I think the rest of us would like to hear you!!!
